Thanks for providing for the needs of others in Jesus' name.

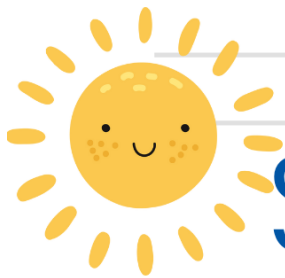
I WANT TO KNOW Christ
